## Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) Scholarship – 2016 - 2017

Specifically we will provide those candidates with a GMAT<sup>®</sup> fee waiver which can be used for one test administration.

### Criteria for Eligibility

- Must be a current UCSD Undergraduate Accounting, Business, or Entrepreneurship & Innovation Minor student OR an International Studies – International Business Major
- Must be a **Senior** graduating during the 2016 – 2017 academic year
- Must have a current overall GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must have a Minor GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Must have economic need, requiring financial assistance with GMAT fee
