General Requirements

- Students must take a total of **6** courses in order to earn the certificate
- Students must earn a B or better in courses applying towards the certificate
- Students should [submit notification](#) to the Graduate Programs office that they are pursuing the certificate.
- A resume and complete academic history submission will be required prior to earning the certificate
- The certificate will not appear on the student's transcript but will be physically issued to the student upon completion of the program.
- If the student wishes to make an exception to the Certificate requirements, the student should seek approval from [Professor Hyoduk Shin](#) via email and then submit [additional notification](#) to Graduate Programs.
