

\$25,000 Call for Academic Papers Contest

UC SAN DIEGO'S BRANDES CENTER INVITES YOU TO SUBMIT AN ENTRY FOR

THE BRANDES PRIZE

We are looking for original, unpublished and not-yet-accepted-for-publication research on <u>value investing</u>. The contest is open to current graduate/post-graduate students and professors. Here are a few suggested topics. <u>ALL entries must focus on some aspect of</u> <u>value investing</u>.

- 1. What are today's most insidious behavioral biases when investing (for individuals and/or institutions)? How do these biases create opportunities—and risks—for value investors?
- 2. How can investors best apply Benjamin Graham-based principles to solve current issues?
- 3. How has artificial intelligence (AI) affected value investing? And how may it influence value creation and/or assessment in the future?
- 4. What macroeconomic developments (inflation, socio-political tensions, climate change, debt levels, etc.) have had the greatest influence on value investing? What does the future hold?
- 5. How has value investing evolved? How can investors best apply value principles today?
- 6. What are today's greatest corporate governance issues? How do they affect firm valuation? How can value investors best respond?

Deadline for submissions: March 31, 2025

- Each paper must include an abstract that summarizes the issue, methodology and solution in 500 words or fewer.
- Each paper will be reviewed by members of The Brandes Center. Winning entries will be selected by members of The Brandes Center Advisory Board, Executive Committee and/or Faculty Council who volunteer as judges.
- COMPENSATION FOR WINNER(S): The Brandes Center will recognize two, winning papers (one by a professor or professors and one by graduate, PhD or postdoctoral students) attending and/or teaching at an accredited university.

The winning entries will split:

• A **\$25,000** total award pool (the split to be determined by the judges). The minimum prize for either winner(s) will be \$5,000. The maximum prize for either winner will be \$20,000. Prize money sponsored by Brandes Investment Partners, L.P.
