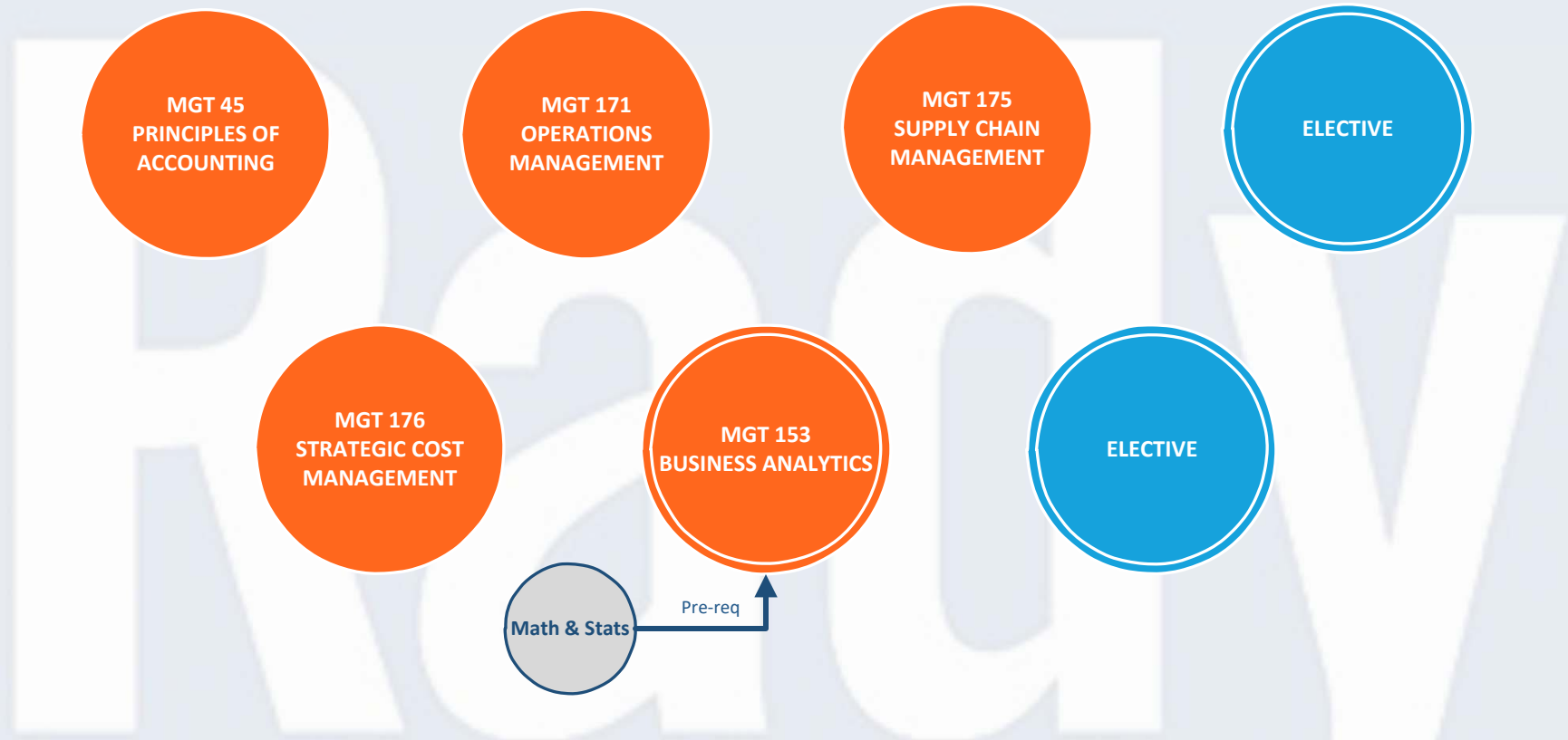


SUPPLY CHAIN MINOR

The Business Minor requires **5 CORE CLASSES** and **2 ELECTIVE CLASSES** = 28 units total



Supply Chain Minor Requirements

- MAX 2 LOWER DIVISION CLASSES
- All classes must be taken as a LETTER GRADE with a grade of C- or better
- Students can overlap 8 upper division units between their major and minor
- Only two transfer courses allowed toward minor requirements

Supply Chain Minor Requirements

The Rady School of Management's Supply Chain minor will provide students with the skills and strategies needed for supply chain operations and management. This program takes an innovative approach to concepts and techniques in the supply chain industry. Students will develop tactical and operational expertise that allow them to excel in the field and promote future career opportunities.

Core Requirements - Students must take five required core courses

- **MGT 45: Principles of Accounting**
- **MGT 153 Business Analytics**
 - This class requires two pre-requisite courses: MATH 10A or MATH 18 or MATH 20A or MATH 31AH **AND** BENG 100 or BIEB 100 or COGS 14B or ECE 109 or ECON 120A or MAE 108 or MATH 11 or MATH 180A or MATH 181A or MATH 183 or MATH 186 or MGT 3 or PSYC 60 or SIO 187
- **MGT 171 Operations Management**
- **MGT 175 Supply Chain Management**
 - Students who completed MGT 174 prior to FA18 will receive equivalent credit for MGT 175.
- **MGT 176 Strategic Cost Management**

Elective Requirements - Students must take two courses or eight units of electives

MGT 128R: Innovation in Service Enterprises
MGT 162: Negotiation (2 units)
MGT 166: Business Ethics and Corporate Social Responsibility
MGT 172: Business Project Management
MGT 177: Analytics and Spreadsheet Modeling
MGT 179: Topics in Supply Chain (2-4 units)
